1055. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST AND CODE OF PRACTICE.

No declarations were made.

1056. PLANNING APPLICATION : SINGLE GARAGE AND OFFICE OVER, 13 RECTORY PLACE

The application was considered and it was agreed to object to it on the grounds that the structure was considered excessive in size as a detached building in relation to its location and was outside the curtilage of the existing building on the site. Additionally it was considered to represent an extension of the building line into the countryside.

1057. PROPOSED SAND AND GRAVEL QUARRY

It was reported that London Rock would be holding an exhibition in the Village Hall on 16 March 2017 to explain their proposals for a sand and gravel quarry at Barton in Fabis, in advance of a formal planning application being submitted. The public enquiry into Nottinghamshire County Council's mineral plan will now be commencing in June.

1058. CORRESPONDANCE

It was reported that the outline planning application for Top Yard had been refused by Rushcliffe Borough Council.

Rushcliffe Borough Council has issued a consultation paper outlining proposals for the need for a further two thousand new homes within the area of the Borough. Responses are required by 31 March 2017.
