## 1060. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING.

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 26 January 2017 and the extraordinary meeting held on 9 March 2017 were approved and signed by the Chairman.

## 1061. **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

No declarations were made.

## 1062. **DISTRICT REPORT.**

It was reported Rushcliffe Borough Councillor Stuart Matthews was prepared to meet the cost of replacing the stonework around the Village seat from his member's allowance, the cost being estimated to be in the region of f1,000.

## 1063. COUNTY REPORT.

Options were being examined to enable the Airport bus to serve the villages of East Leake and Gotham. Exploratory boreholes were being drilled in the northern part of the County. The camera car in use by the County had had success in dealing with parking issues within the vicinity schools in some parts of the County and representations had been made for it to cover the southern part of the County too. Highways England has been requested to set out the issues relating to adopting Barton Lane as a public highway, currently it has the status as a bridleway and private access to properties served by it. The subject of responsibility of clearing litter on Green Street was also raised.

# 1064. CLIFTON PASTURES PLANNING APPLICATION.

Nothing further to report since the previous meeting. It was also noted that a delay was likely in the production of the Rushcliffe Local Plan.

# 1065. SAND AND GRAVEL QUARRY: BARTON IN FABIS.

It was reported that the planning application for this was likely to be submitted before Easter, with a consultation period of fourteen to sixteen weeks being available for interested parties to comment.

# 1066. FLOODING MANOR ROAD.

Following a recent period of heavy rain, flooding of the roads in the centre of the Village had occurred which was thought to be due to the blockage of the drains. Rushcliffe Borough Council to be requested to arrange for them to be cleared.

## 1067. BARTON LODGE.

It was reported that a retrospective planning application would be submitted for the fencing works.

## 1068. **FINANCE.**

The clerk circulated a statement expenditure and income against the current year budget covering the period until 30 March 2017, the contents of which were noted.

Cheques totalling £661.81 were approved for payment.
