1175. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING.

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 1 November 2018 were approved and signed
by the Chairman.

1176. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.

No declarations were made.

1177. DISTRICT REPORT.

Proposals by Nottinghamshire County Council to reorganise local government within
Nottinghamshire have been put on hold. A meeting is to be held in Gotham on 19
February 2019 to consider traffic issues within the locality. Representatives from
Nottinghamshire County Council will be in attendance. Councillor Rex Walker has a
meeting scheduled for 31 January 2019 with Nottinghamshire County Council officers to
discuss issues relating to proposals for sand and gravel quarrying within the area. There
was a meeting prior to Christmas with the developers for Fairham Pastures and Rushcliffe
Borough Council covering progress on the development. A presentation to Village
residents will take place prior to the submission of the detailed planning application.

1178. NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL MINERALS LOCAL PLAN.

This is not much further to report. The responses to the consultation process have still to
be made available on the County Council's website. The next stage will be the publication
of the draft plan. It was noted that the proposed extension to a site at East Leake would
not now be going ahead. By early March it is expected that the assessment of the expected
supply of minerals for the next seven years would be made available.

1179. PLANNING APPLICATION, PROPOSED SAND AND GRAVEL QUARRY.

The applicant has provided further information in response to the Section 25 request. A
response to this will be prepared and it is possible that the matter could be considered by
the Planning Committee in April.

1180. VILLAGE ENTRANCE.

Options for features to be included on the signage for the Village entrance at the top of New Road have been submitted and it was agreed that this would be included on the agenda for the annual Village Meeting. Options for the financing of the project would also be presented at that stage.

1181. ANNUAL VILLAGE MEETING.

The date for the Annual Village Meeting was set for 23 May 2019.

1182. FINANCE.

The clerk circulated a statement setting out payments and receipts to 21 January 2019. It was agreed that the report be noted

Cheques totalling £969.40 were approved for payment

Approval was given to a donation of £200 to the Baron in Bloom appeal.

The budget for 2019/2020 was considered and it was resolved that the precept be set at £3,717, a percentage reduction of 6.7%.
