

BARTON IN FABIS PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Meeting of Barton in Fabis Parish Council held on Thursday 21
January 2021 at 7:35 p.m. held remotely

1312. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.

No declarations were made.

1313. MINUTES.

The minutes of the meeting held on 5 November 2020 were approved for signature by the Chairman.

1314. COUNTY REPORT.

It was reported that the Minerals Local Plan would be available for comment to be provided to the Inspector following the public examination. The application from Unipur for the incinerator on the power station site at Ratcliffe is expected to go to the County Planning Committee on 9 February 2021

1315. DISTRICT REPORT.

The Development Corporation proposals for the Ratcliffe Power Station site requires clarification, following a meeting that had been held to discuss the issue. Fly tipping is still a concern within Rushcliffe and a series of measures are in place to tackle the problem. A reminder was given that there are still Ward funds available for local groups to access.

1316. FAIRHAM DEVELOPMENT.

Concerns were raised that there appears to be some slippage on the development. Prospective developers will use the design code before submission of the application to Rushcliffe.

1317. GREATER NOTTINGHAM STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP.

An update was provided as to how the five parishes of Barton in Fabis, Gotham, Thrumpton, Kingston on Soar, and Ratcliffe on Soar should respond to the Greater Nottingham Strategic Partnership. It was agreed to become part of the five parish

approach in order to provide a coordinated response. Representation on the steering group would consist of two representatives from four of the parishes, with Gotham having three members. A fighting fund would be set up, with contributions being prorata to population. Barton in Fabis would also take the lead on the financial arrangements.

1318. **FINANCE.**

The clerk circulated a statement setting out payments and receipts to 18 January 2021 was circulated. It was agreed that the report be noted.

Cheques totalling £36.00 were submitted for approval.

The budget for 2021/2022 was considered and it was resolved that the precept be set at £5,446, a zero percentage change.
