1437. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST.

No declarations were made.

1438 MINUTES.

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 14 July 2022 and the Extraordinary meeting held on 24 October 2022 were approved for signature by the Chairman.

1439 DISTRICT REPORT.

It was reported that the planning application for the Chestnut Lane site had been refused by Rushcliffe Borough Council. An application for a Solar Panel Farm at Church Lane Kingston on Soar has received approval. The Local Development Framework for the Ratcliffe Power Station site has received approval and consultation on the preferred option for the site is being pursued. In his absence a note for County Councillor Mat Barney was circulated outlining the County report.

1440 FAIRHAM DEVELOPMENT.

There was nothing further to report on progress of the site's development. The Fairham Growth Board meets on 16 November 2022 when an update is expected..

1441 FIVE PARISHES GROUP.

The Five Parishes Group had met and prepared a response to consultation on the Local Development Framework for the Ratcliffe Power Station site. It has also responded to consultation on changes to the flightpaths serving East Midlands Airport. On outstanding issue is the training flights, which were not part of the consultation.

1442 **FINANCE**

The clerk circulated a statement setting out payments and receipts to 31 October 2022. It was agreed that the report be noted.
